As you will start to notice, our decodables are increasing in difficulty. They will continue to get longer as we progress and the dialogue will also increase with each story. Remember to read with expression. 😊 We also have been practicing our sentence writing and making sure we have an uppercase, finger space and period!

We are working on measurement and addition in Math. Both of these concepts are being taught through various hands-on activities in class and then reinforced on the papers that you see come home. Right now we are learning addition using manipulatives, but in the next few weeks we will move on to learning our facts. This year we will master addition facts from +0 to +5 with sums up to 12. Now is a great time to pick up a set of addition flashcards and start working on them at home with your child.

In Social Studies we have learned about Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas and California . Be sure to ask your child to tell you something about each of these great states. This week we will learn about Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, and Florida. We will finish up with Georgia and then I will be sending home review packets for our first state assessment.

In Science, we will be learning about the weather and the seasons. 😊
